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| 1. Neblina Sauvignon Blanc, Chile, 2009 | 13.95 |
| Youthful, lively and fresh, this Sauvignon Blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a zesty citrus palate. | |
| 2. Coldridge Estate Chardonnay, Australia, 2009 | 13.95 |
| This classic Australian Chardonnay offers fresh ripe fruit characters, with a soft yet flavoursome butterscotch finish. | |
| 3. Gavi La Lancelotta, Italy, 2009 | 16.95 |
| Delicious crispy citrus notes and refreshing acidity with discernible apricot and peach flavours. | |
| 4. La Grille Chenin Blanc, France, 2008 | 17.95 |
| Plenty of white flower and peach characters from the fully ripe Chenin Blanc grapes make this a delicious, off dry white. | |
| 5. Bourgogne Blanc, Les Chenaudieres, France, 2008 | 19.95 |
| . Crisp and elegant with citrus and apple fruit characters alongside a lovely streak of minerality. | |
| 6. Muga Blanco, Spain, 2009 | 19.95 |
| A beautifully made white Rioja packed with juicy ripe fruit with hints of cinnamon and a mouth watering, elegant finish. | |
| 7. Viognier Gerard Bertrand, France, 2009 | 19.95 |
| A beautifully balanced wine delivering lush tropical fruit flavours and an excellent crisp finish. | |
| 8. Dart Valley Reserve, Sharpham, Devon | 19.95 |
| Produced just a few miles up the River Dart. Light and crisp with good minerality | |
| 9. Paul Mas Estate Marsanne, France, 2009 | 21.95 |
| An elegant wine with white flower and hazelnut aromas and delicious pear and honey flavours. | |

10. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2009 22.95

A well-balanced wine with a fruit -driven palate with a lasting and refreshing finish.

11. Falangina San Gregorio, Italy, 2008 26.95

With a nose reminiscent of pear drops and a complexity of tropical fruit.

12. La Nuit Blanche Roussanne, France, 2008 26.95

Rich and creamy with exotic fruit aromas, with fresh mandarin notes and nuts on the palate

13. Albarino Martin Codax, Spain, 2008 26.95

Offers a delicate yet forceful peachy aroma on the nose and palate and is a great choice if you prefer something a little different to Chardonnay.

14. Sancerre Roger Neveu, France, 2007 29.95

Beautifully balanced and supremely refined with grassy aromatic fruit character and a lively, tangy finish.

15. Chablis 1er cru Montmains, France, 2008 32.95

Top quality Chardonnay grapes result in a wine with mineral undertones and crisp citrus and ripe pineapple fruits.

RED WINES

16. Neblina Merlot, Chile, 2009 **13.95**

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha.

17. Coldridge Estate Shiraz Cabernet, Australia, 2009 **13.95**

A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours.

18. Aires Andinos Malbec, Argentina, 2009 **15.95**

A rich, ripe wine with plenty of smooth black fruit and warming hints of spice.

19. Chateau du Gaudou, Cahors, France, 2007 **17.95**

Lots of ripe, black fruit with the Merlot rounding out the tannins to give a softer, more approachable appeal.

20. Beaujolais-Villages, Chateau de Maladrets, 2008 **18.95**

Cracking, juicy, fresh new Beaujolais from the greatest year on record!

21. Beyerskloof Pinotage, South Africa 2008 **19.95**

This Pinotage has all the ripeness of the Cape's best wines, and with a lovely long smokey finish.

22. Chateau Mont Milan, Corbieres, France, 2007 **19.95**

An intense nose of cooked and dried fruit, dates and vanilla, full and rounded on the palate with remarkable finesse.

23. Chateau Prieures Les Tours, France 2001 **21.95**

A harmonious bouquet is dominated by smoky bramble fruit and a touch of spice. Rich and opulent on the palate it has perfectly balanced tannins .

24. Otterbrook Mill Shiraz, Australia 2009 **21.95**

A lovely, smooth wine showing notes of plum and dark, berry fruits with a delicate, spicy finish

RED WINES – cont

25. Pinot Noir Les Valmoissine Louis Latour, France 2008 24.95

The grapes are sourced from the Vars region which is well placed to receive maximum sunshine throughout the summer but remains cool during spring time hence retaining a good crisp acidity.

26. Cotes Du Rhone Belleruche, France 2008 24.95

Its deep ruby/purple hue is accompanied by aromas of blackberries, cherries, road tar, and earth. Medium-bodied with silky tannins.

27. Valpolicella Classico Ripasso, Italy 2005/2006 25.95

Full-bodied and velvet smooth, hints of cherries and spices come through on the palate creating a mass of rich and intense flavours.

28. Quinta de Crasto, Portugal, 2008 26.95

With intense aromas of blackberries and raspberries on the nose, the palate is bursting with wild berry character

29. Rioja Gran Reserva Berberana, Spain 2002 28.95

A stunning Gran Reserva. Complex layers of mellow toasted oak and baked fruit flavours and a sumptuous lingering finish

30. Chateauneuf Du Pape Clos Mont Olivet, France 2004 34.95

Juicy blackcurrant and blueberry flavours fill the mouth while aromas of leather, smoke and Asian spices fill the nose. Good heady stuff!

31. Chateau de Sales, France 2006 42.95

From the largest property in Pomerol comes this up front yet easy drinking Claret. Soft Merlot dominated texture gives the wine an approachable mouth feel.

ROSÉ WINES

32. Bois de Violettes Rosé, France 2008 **15.95**

Wonderfully fresh with intense aromas of violet and lychee. The palate is youthful, juicy, and rich.

33. La Grille Rosé, France 2008 **17.95**

This Pinot Noir Rose has fresh strawberry and spice flavours, so typical of this great grape variety.

34. Ch de Sours Bordeaux Rosé, France 2008 **19.95**

This is a gloriously deep, bright rosé colour with rich fruit flavours and a long lingering finish.

SPARKLING

35. Prosecco Rabosa Rosé, NV, Italy **18.95**

Dry, soft and elegant with a round and full-bodied structure.

36. Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene Extra Dry, NV **21.95**

This fine, fruity Prosecco reveals hints of apples and pineapples. Ideal as an apéritif or to accompany light food.

37. Canard-Duchêne Brut, NV, Champagne, France **35.95**

An excellent Champagne with a clean, easily accessible style.

DESSERT

38. Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc 2006 **15.95**

This sumptuous wine displays ripe papaya, peach and honey aromas. The palate is light, fresh and fruity with a long, subtle, honeyed finish

39. Elysium Black Muscat, 2008 **19.95**

Virtually black in colour, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich, velvety fruit.

40. Bimbadgen Botrytis Semillion 2006 **21.95**

Delicious tropical fruits aromas of lime and apricot are joined by more complex notes of toffee, toast and vanilla bean.

41. Banyuls Reserva, Domaine de la Tour Vielle **32.95**

Rich, sweet and figgy, great with Chocolate

Herb tinged resinous bouquet with sherry like undertones

Collines Rhodaniennes, Le Pied de Samson, Condrieu 2008 **£35.95**
A classic Viognier, honeysuckle and peach aromas with a long dry finish

ROSE

Vin de Corse Sartène, Domaine Sarapale, 2009 **£24.95**
A pale rosé with red berry aromas and a long clean finish. Wonderful.

Saint Pourcain, La Ficelle 2009 **£22.95**
Juicy red fruit over gentle tannins. Gamay and Pinot Noir

Perfect with heavier red meat, Cinsault, Syrah and Mouverde

Mid weight, dark purple peppery red Syrah from the Northern Rhone

Warm Autumn fruit, subtle spice and herbs, and ripe tannins
